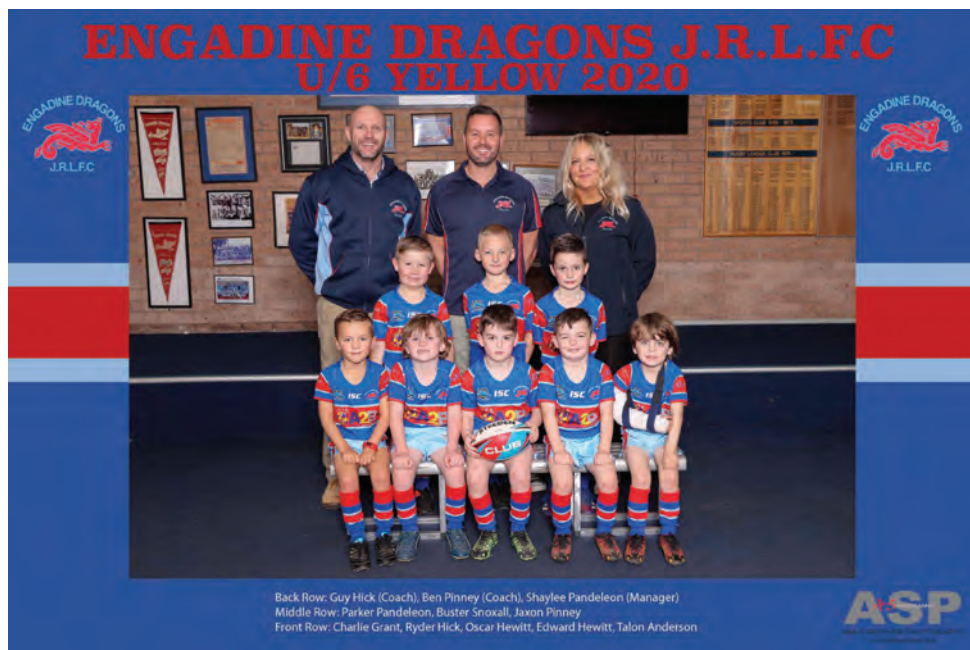
Max Ruello

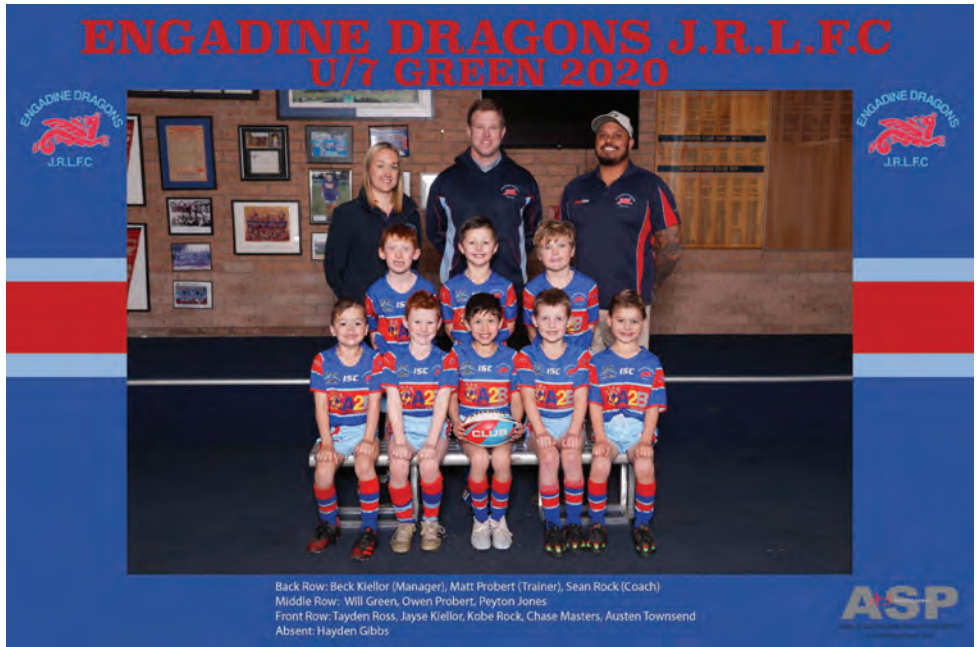

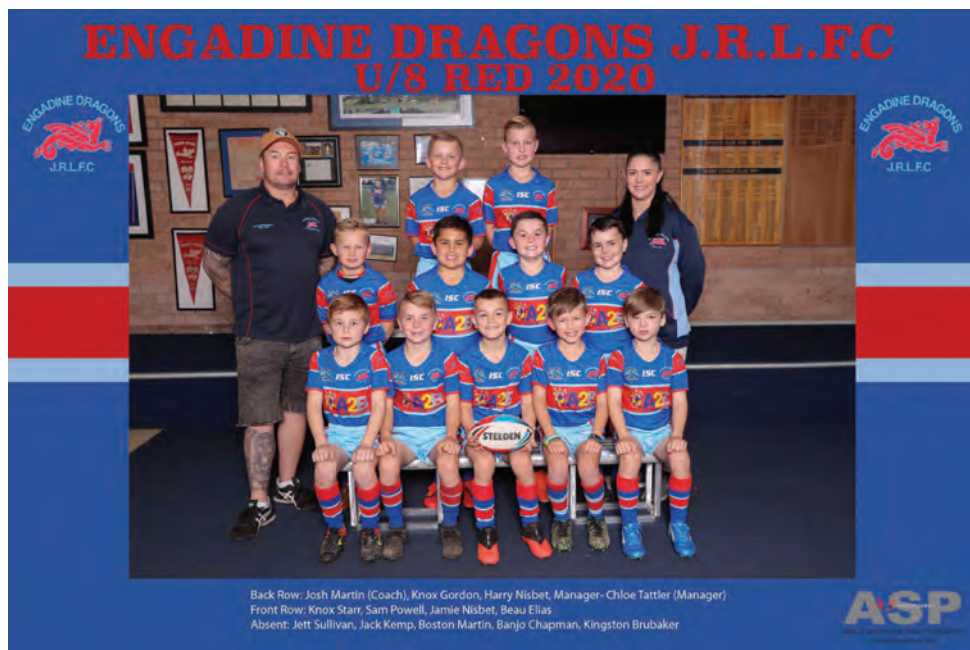

By Round 8 most of the boys were back from suspension but we then had a bye in Round 10, so really the year was very disjointed, stop/start competition.

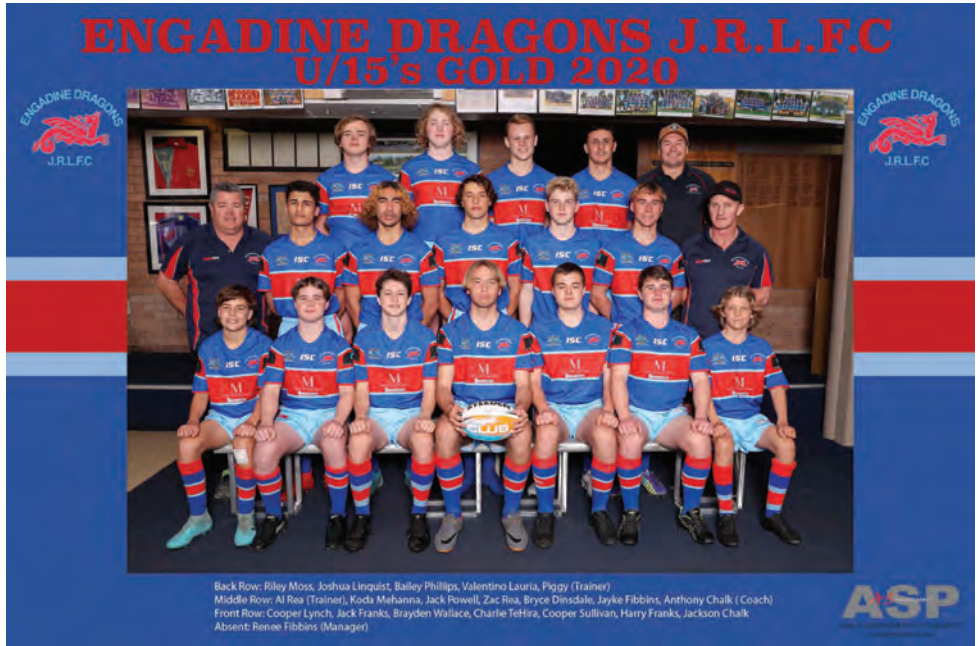
